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Purpose: To ensure all firefighting personnel can safely and efficiently deploy a 2-½ inch attack line for knockdown and preparing for an 1-¾ (or 1-½) line advancement via a hose bundle. Personnel shall meet the training and evolution in this standard for the above identified area under the allowed time frame and with all proper personal protective equipment as needed.

Scope: All firefighting personnel.

Training: Personnel should review both the training video on the Blitz attack line and bundle operations. Understanding that the blitz line is made of 2-½ inch hose, 150 feet in length. The line has a smooth bore nozzle with a bail. The smooth bore nozzle has a 1-¼ tip with a 1-½ male thread showing. This will allow for the 1-½ gated wye to be attached from the hose bundle.

Evolution 1: (as a 2 person crew)

Deploy the Blitz line to the targeted area, initiate fire flow with water. Prep and set up the bundle for operation. Shutting down the fire flow from the blitz line, connect the wye and initiate fire flow on the one bundle line. One firefighter operation on the nozzle as the second firefighter preps a cross lay for shouldering and connect to the second discharge on the wye.

- - All PPE including SCBA, Radio, Flashlight, tool must be on.
- - Fire hose and nozzle must be at the proper flow and pressure.
- - Hose must be deployed to the point of entry to be easily pulled into the structure (flaked out).
