Scope: All firefighting personnel.

Training: Be able to perform the following, don and doff the SCBA (all models of air pack which the department has in service), fill the SCBA bottle after use, proper cleaning of the SCBA and mask after use, Knowledge of the UAC fill system and buddy breathing system and general operating system parts of the SCBA.

Evolution 1:

Don the SCBA

- **All PPE (turnouts coat, hood) on prior to start, helmet gloves and mask can be placed alongside the firefighter to be donned during the drill.**
- **Time stops once the SCBA is on and the firefighter is on air with all PPE donned correctly.**
- **No skin can be shown once completed.**
- ***** Allowed only 50 seconds max for this drill.**

Evolution 2:

Fill the SCBA bottle showing proper technique.

Evolution 3:

As a crew of 2 or more, in limited low light condition, crew must be able to work together to use the buddy breathing system. As a crew they must exit with one crew member providing air via the buddy breather and the other crew member is being supplied air from their partner.

- **All PPE donned.**
- **Using clear communication, working together to overcome the problem and exit the drill area.**
